Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel. Then board your coach for visit Mt. Fuji

Mount Fuji is the highest peak in Japan. It is an active volcano It is the tallest mountain in Japan, the second-highest volcano located on an island in Asia, which is covered in snow for about five months of the year, the Mt Fuji erupted last time in 1707. In 2011 there was a major earthquake, which increased the pressure inside Mt. Fuji, but no eruption.

- Brief photo stop at the iconic "Mt. Fuji" sign.
- Optional short walk around the visitor centre to stretch and admire the view (weather permitting).
- Drive to Hakone : Scenic route through the foothills
- Lake Ashi Boat Cruise
- Board a piratical-style cruise on Lake Ashi. The cruise offers panoramic views of Mt. Fuji reflected on the water and passes by the historic Hakone Shrine torii gate.
- For Lunch, dine at the Indian restaurant

Owakudani Ropeway & Volcanic Valley

- Take the Hakone Ropeway up to Owakudani, a steaming volcanic valley.
- Walk the short trail to the sulphur vents and try the famous black eggs (kuro-tamago) boiled in the hot springs.
- Enjoy sweeping views of the surrounding mountains and, on a clear day, a distant glimpse of Mt. Fuji. Ride the ropeway back down, then board the vehicle for the return journey to Tokyo. Dinner at the Indian Restaurant.

**DAY 05 04.06.2026**

**TOKYO TO HIROSHIMA (BULLET TRAIN) || MIYAJIMA ISLAND || RETURN BACK TO HIROSHIMA**

After breakfast, bid farewell to Tokyo as you check out from the hotel and proceed to Tokyo station. Get ready for a truly Japanese experience as you board the legendary Shinkansen (Bullet Train)— renowned worldwide for its incredible speed, smooth comfort, and unmatched punctuality— racing towards Hiroshima.

- Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park: Walk through the tranquil grounds, visit the A-Bomb Dome (the skeletal remains of the former Industrial Promotion Hall).
- Atomic Bomb Dome: Spend about 30 minutes learning about the atomic bombing and its aftermath.
- Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum: Children’s Peace Monument and Peace Flame for a reflective moment.

Take a refreshing break and enjoy a delicious Indian lunch at a local restaurant, perfectly timed to recharge before the afternoon exploration.

**Miyajima Island – Itsukushima Shrine**

- Board a short ferry from Miyajimaguchi Port. The ferry ride offers a view of the Seto Inland Sea.
- Explore the iconic Itsukushima Shrine with its famous floating torii gate.
- Stroll along the scenic waterfront promenade, browse souvenir shops, and enjoy local treats such as momiji-manju (maple-leaf shaped cake – own arrangement).
- Ferry back to the mainland

Return back to Hiroshima. Transfer to hotel & check in.

Dinner at the Indian restaurant.

Walk through this great gate, and see the magnificent large wooden Ni-o statues. housed in the great Nandaimon Gates

- Nara Park

Located next to Todaiji Temple, Nara Park is a spacious area filled with historic temples and ponds, where deer roam freely. With its beautiful scenery that changes with the seasons, it is one of Nara's most iconic destinations.

- Lunch

Dine at at the Indian restaurant

- Osaka Castle (Photo Stop)

- Osaka Castle stands as a timeless symbol of Japan's rich history and grandeur. Originally built in the late 16th century, this iconic fortress is celebrated for its striking architecture and historical significance  
- Snap photos of the iconic golden-leaved tower, and explore the surrounding gardens.

- Umeda Sky Building

The Umeda Sky Building is a modern marvel in Osaka, renowned for its elegant design and spectacular views. Completed in 1993, this iconic structure features twin towers linked by a floating garden observatory, creating a unique and striking silhouette against the skyline. On your tour, a guide will share intriguing details about the building's design and history. Inside, you'll find a sleek, contemporary interior that sets the stage for a memorable experience. The highlight is the "Floating Garden Observatory," offering breathtaking 360-degree views of Osaka and beyond.

- Kinkaku-ji (Golden Pavilion)

Kinkakuji, also known as the Golden Pavilion, is a stunning Zen Buddhist temple located in Kyoto. Famous for its top two floors covered in gold leaf, the temple reflects beautifully on the surrounding pond, creating a picturesque scene

- Philosopher's Path

The Philosopher's Path (哲学の道) is one of Kyoto's most scenic and peaceful walking routes, stretching for about two kilometers along the canal that runs through the northern part of the city, near Ginkaku-ji (Silver Pavilion). The path is named after the famous philosopher Nishida Kitaro, who is said to have walked this route for inspiration and reflection during his years as a professor at Kyoto University. The path is lined with over 1000 cherry trees, making it particularly enchanting during spring when the blossoms create a stunning canopy of soft pink flowers. The route is equally beautiful in the fall, when the leaves turn vibrant red and orange, offering a contrast to the calm, reflective waters of the canal. Along the way, visitors will encounter small temples, shrines, and traditional teahouses, adding to the cultural atmosphere.

- Arashiyama Bamboo Forest

A Magical Experience in Kyoto The Arashiyama Bamboo Grove offers a truly immersive natural experience. Located in the Arashiyama district, this serene bamboo forest is a must-visit destination for nature lovers and photographers. Walking through the towering bamboo stalks, which can reach up to 30 meters tall, feels like stepping into another world. The soft rustling of the bamboo leaves in the breeze creates a peaceful, almost

mystical atmosphere, making it a perfect escape from the bustle of city life. The narrow paths wind through the grove, allowing visitors to explore and enjoy the beauty of nature from every angle. The Bamboo Grove is particularly striking during early morning or late afternoon, when the light filters through the bamboo, casting ethereal shadows and highlighting the vibrant green of the leaves. In winter, the grove has a serene, crisp beauty, while in summer; the cool shade offers a welcome respite from the heat.

- Lunch (En-route)

Stop at the nearby Indian Restaurant.

- Fushimi Inari Shrine

Kyoto's Famous Shrine of Thousand Torii Gates Fushimi Inari Taisha is one of Kyoto's most famous and spiritual landmarks, well-known for its thousands of torii gates that lead visitors up the slopes of Mount Inari. Dedicated to Inari, the Shinto god of rice, agriculture, and prosperity, Fushimi Inari Taisha is a significant site for both spiritual pilgrims and travelers looking to experience Japan's unique blend of nature and religion.

The shrine complex is popular for its long, winding paths lined with vibrant red torii gates, known as Senbon Torii ("thousand torii gates"). These gates create a stunning corridor that stretches for over 4 kilometers up the mountain, offering a picturesque journey. Each gate is a donation from individuals or businesses, with the donor's name and the date on the back. It takes about 2-3 hours to hike at the summit of Mount Inari, but smaller shrines and resting spots along the way provide a peaceful and rewarding journey

Proceed to kimono rental shop, change into a traditional outfit, and stroll the historic streets for photos.

- Nishiki Market

Walk a few blocks to the bustling "Kyoto's Kitchen." Sample local snacks—matcha sweets, grilled seafood, pickles, and fresh mochi. This is a good spot to pick up souvenirs.

Coach heads back to Osaka
